

In these last two places the ore-deposits will be the main features of study and the students will see how the mineral is treated in the smelters and concentration plants. Some of the students have suggested buying Fords and making the trip in them. This method would probably be as economical as going by train, and the Fords could be used to good advantage on the smaller trips that are to be made after the party reaches Colorado.
